CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION FACILITIES FUNDING

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To present requests for funding under the Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP).

DESCRIPTION

Under the CTEFP, a local education agency (LEA) operating a comprehensive high school may construct new or modernize existing facilities for career technical education programs. A Joint Powers Authority (JPA) which has been operating a career technical education program as of May 20, 2006 may modernize existing facilities. The LEA is not required to demonstrate that it has unhoused pupils or that buildings are older than 25 years to be eligible for the program. The maximum grant for a new construction project is \$3 million. The maximum grant for a modernization project is \$1.5 million. A district may submit multiple projects on the same school site.

A financial contribution toward the cost of the CTEFP project must be equal to the State's share (50/50 State and District funding). The local contribution toward the project cannot be waived. The LEA or JPA may request a loan for all or part of the local contribution if funds are not immediately available.

AUTHORITY

Assembly Bill 127, Chapter 35, Statutes of 2006 (Nunez/Perata) established the CTEFP within the School Facility Program (SFP). Education Code Section 17078.72 provides \$500 million dollars from Proposition 1D for qualifying applicants to construct or modernize facilities and to purchase equipment for career technical education programs at high schools.

SFP Regulation Section 1859.194 allows qualifying applicants to request a loan if the matching share is unavailable.

SFP Regulation Section 1859.195 establishes the funding cycles and the distribution of funds within each cycle. In the second funding cycle, \$150 million, plus the amount remaining from funding cycle one, is distributed proportionally to the Service Regions based on high school enrollment.

SFP Regulation Section 1859.196(b) defines the funding order of projects. If funds remain in a given Service Region after all projects have been funded, Section (c) states that the remaining funds shall be pooled and apportioned to the highest ranked project in each locale regardless of Service Region.

STAFF COMMENTS

For this second funding cycle, there is \$294,657,206 available for the Board to apportion to qualifying applications. Staff received 290 applications. There are 244 applications presented to the Board for apportionment totaling \$211,819,577 including loans as follows:

- 219 projects for \$168.6 million are funded by Service Region.
- 25 projects for \$43.2 million are funded from the Pooled Funds.

Attachment A provides a listing of all applications by Service Region submitted for funding. Some Service Regions are oversubscribed. The applications in the oversubscribed Service Regions are funded from the pool of funds remaining in undersubscribed Regions. Attachment B is a list of qualifying applications that are being funded from the pool of remaining funds, as allowed under Regulation Section 1859.196(c). This pool is sufficient to fund all qualifying applications received within this cycle. Funds remaining from cycle two shall carry over to cycle three.

Five applicants are approved for a loan. Upon apportionment, the Office of Public School Construction will execute a loan agreement on behalf of the Board for these applicants. The applicants have up to ten years starting from the date of the fund release to repay the loan. Interest starts accruing on the fund release date.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Apportion \$211,819,577 as shown on Attachments A and B.
2. Require applicants who requested a reservation of funds to submit the required approvals from the California Department of Education and the Division of the State Architect within 12 months of apportionment.
3. Require all loan applicants to submit a complete loan agreement within 30 days of apportionment.
4. Authorize Staff to automatically release ten percent of the CTEFP grant to applicants who have requested a loan equal to the entire matching share.
5. Approve all special conditions on the attached funding items.
